



## **Questionnaire Glossary**

| Term                  | Definition                                                                                                            |

| Survey                | The process of collecting information from a group of people to gain an understanding of a particular topic or issue. |
| Variable              | A characteristic or measure that can take on different values in a questionnaire or study.                            |
| Measure               | How a variable is quantified or observed in a questionnaire or study.                                                 |
| Question Type         | The format of a question in a questionnaire, such as multiple-choice, open-ended, or Likert scale.                    |
| Desk Review           | An evaluation of the questionnaire design by reviewing it for clarity, relevance, and potential issues.               |
| Pilot Survey          | A small-scale trial of the questionnaire to test its effectiveness and make necessary refinements.                    |
| Contextual Knowledge  | Understanding of the relevant background information and setting related to the survey topic.                         |
| Statistical Knowledge | Understanding of statistical concepts and methods used in data collection, analysis, and interpretation.              |
